DISASTER SURVIVAL KIT

In the event of an emergency or disaster, you will need a Disaster Survival kit that you can use at home or take with you in case you must evacuate the area. Basic supplies in this kit include the following:

- **Water— 1 gallon per person, per day. 3-day supply for evacuation, 2-weeks, home.**
- **Food—non-perishable items. 3-day supply for evacuation, 2-week supply for home.**
- **Manual can opener.**
- **Flashlights.**
- **Battery-powered radio.**
- **Two-way radios**
- **Extra batteries.**
- **Cell phone with charger.**
- **First Aid Kit.**
- **Medications - 7-day supply.**
- **Sanitation and personal hygiene items.**
- **Personal documents - medications, proof of address, passports, insurance policies, etc.**
- **Family and emergency contact information.**
- **Extra cash, credit and ATM cards.**
- **Blankets, towels, sleeping bags and pillows.**
- **Local and state maps.**
- **Hearing aids with extra batteries, glasses, contact lenses, etc.**
- **Baby supplies - bottles, formula, baby food, diapers.**
- **Games for children.**
- **Pet supplies - collar, leash, ID, food, carrier, bowl.**
- **Extra set of car keys and house keys.**
- **Whistle.**
- **Surgical masks.**
- **Matches.**
- **Rain gear.**
- **Work gloves.**
- **Tools/supplies for securing your home.**
- **Extra clothing, hat and work shoes.**
- **Plastic sheeting.**
- **Duct tape.**
- **Scissors.**
- **Household liquid bleach.**
